

We have established an institutional subscription to the **Fundamentals of Clinical Education (FCE)** program, jointly developed by the Academy for Advancing Leadership (AAL) and Penn Dental Medicine. The program is designed specifically for dental clinical educators to support teaching efforts in the clinic. Our subscription provides on-demand, 24/7 access to five modules of training, each taking 30-60 min to complete. The modules consist of instructional videos, short lectures, faculty and student interviews, and simulations. Topics include techniques for effective communication with students in the clinic, understanding different learning styles, cultural competencies, diversity and inclusion, student motivation techniques, and best practices for student assessment and feedback. Especially timely is also a segment on understanding the process of accreditation and the standards set by the Commission on Dental Accreditation. In addition to Division-based calibration, this program is an excellent tool in calibrating clinical faculty at the School level.

This program is open to full-time, part-time and volunteer faculty at the SDM. Faculty who complete this online program will receive a certificate of completion and documentation for 7.5 (ADA CERP) CE credits. Please note that individual subscriptions to the program cost \$395, which is completely waived by our institutional subscription.
